Upon your arrival to LANL please check in at the **Badge Office** before proceeding to the Magnet Lab.


Two forms of ID that prove citizenship are required. Driver's license AND original birth certificate OR passport fit the requirements.

LEFT on Diamond Drive


LEFT on Pajarito Road
